In addition to that, there is an attempt to centralise higher education in violation of the constitutional principles specifying a role for both the state and the central governments in the field of higher education. Apart from that, the dismal national scenario; farmers agitation, speedy rise of essential commodities, neo-liberal economic policies, anti labour laws, NRC, corporatization & communalisation etc need immediate attention

AIFUCTO made specific representations regarding the plight. Guaranteed pension scheme still eludes the post 2004 appointees. This Conference is being held at a critical phase and the AIFUCTO which is in the vanguard of the teachers' movement has a significant role to play, for which the conference has to discuss and show proper direction to the movement.
