Dear Friends,

Warm Greetings and Best wishes to all of you.

AIFUCTO, in spite of Corona impact, continues to organize its activities in a full scale. The month of November has witnessed mass protest spear headed by **Joint Forum for Movement of Education (JFME)** and by its components against **National Education Policy. On the National Education Day, 11th November 2021**, AIFUCTO affiliates in response to the JFME's call organize awareness programme exposing the undemocratic, unscientific and exclusionary character of NEP-2020. **AIFUCTO fully express its solidarity to the organisational programme of Sanjukta Kishan Sangharsha Morcha to be carried on 26th November, the day of one year completion of unprecedented farmer's Agitation of the Country against three draconian farm laws.** AIFUCTO also they also share its concern for the ongoing movement of the co-ordination committee of central trade unions against the undemocratic labour laws and anti people economic policy of the Govt. of India. AIFUCTO also views seriously the recent pronouncement of the leading figures of the country including Kangana Ranwat distorting the history of the nation with

damaging consequent on multi-cultural, multi religion and multi lingual identity of our great nation.

AIFUCTO Protest programme of 23rd November : Wearing Black Badge on 23rd November 2021 by all its affiliates :-

In spite of series of agitation programme, assurance by Govt. of the state, written memorandum of AIFUCTO to the heads of concerned states, 7th revised UGC Scales of pay yet is to be implemented in the states of Punjab, HP and Union Territory of Chandigarh. Employees of the states have got the benefit of 7th pay revision where as University and College teacher have been discriminated. As per the existing provision UGC Pay scale revision is to be first implemented in the state of Punjab then to be followed by Himanchal Pradesh and Chandigarh. AIFUCTO expressed its anguish and deep resentment against the attitude of Govt. of Punjab for not considering the implantation of revised UGC scales of pay. AIFUCTO had already sent an appeal to the new C.M and Education Minister of Punjab to implement 7th UGC scales of pay without any further delay.

Disgusted and dissatisfied with the attitude of state Govt. even after series agitation programme and rightly being apprehensive that the process will further delay once election to the state assembly of the Punjab announced. **Punjab affiliates of AIFUCTO have decided to organize “Court Arrest” Programme before of the Chief Minister of Punjab on 23rd November 2021. AIFUCTO as the marks of solidarity has decided to extend all support to the movement and all affiliates across the country will wear Black Badge as mark of solidarity with the Punjab teachers on 23rd November 2021.** Affiliates are requested

to take immediate organizational steps to make the solidarity programmes effective and meaningful.
